Order of Discussion

The Florida Historical Commission will convene at 8:00 a.m. (Eastern time) on Thursday, November 2, 2017, to review and score the FY2019 Historic Preservation Special Category Grant Applications. The intention is for all eligible applications to be reviewed and scored on that day, but there is the possibility that the meeting will be extended to the morning of Friday, November 3, 2017, if additional time is needed. The applications will be reviewed by their application review number (numbered geographically, from Escambia County in Northwest Florida to Monroe County in Southwest Florida). Discussion of applications will continue until the conclusion of the grant reviews and approval of the recommended funding list.

Type of Discussion

The staff of the Division of Historical Resources will present the results of their technical review of each application. Florida Historical Commission members may direct questions to applicants during the meeting, staff recommends that at least one representative be present or available by telephone to represent each project and answer any questions from the Florida Historical Commission. No presentations may be given by applicants, due to time constraints.
