Florida Virtual Campus (FLVC) Overview

The Florida Virtual Campus (FLVC) is a statewide provider of innovative educational support services for all public postsecondary institutions within the Florida College System (FCS) and the State University System (SUS), and for the larger K-20 education community.

FLVC actively collaborates with Florida's **28 public colleges**, **12 public universities**, **K-12 school districts**, and other partners to offer services that help students succeed in school and life after graduation.




Florida Virtual Campus (FLVC) Overview

FLVC was originally created in Florida Statute in 2012 through the consolidation of four statewide organizations: the College Center for Library Automation (CCLA), the Florida Center for Library Automation (FCLA), the Florida Center for Advising and Academic Support (FCAAS), and the Florida Distance Learning Consortium (FDLC).


In 2021, F.S. 1006.73 redefined FLVC within the Florida Postsecondary Academic Library Network (FPALN). FLVC is administratively housed as an Auxiliary Unit of the Northwest Regional Data Center (NWRDC) at Florida State University (FSU).








FLVC Core Services






- Support services for statewide higher education distance learning

Electronic Resources

- Statewide collection of electronic resources (databases, scholarly journals, newspapers, video, etc.)
 - Price negotiations, contracts, licensing
 - \$6.8 million annually state appropriation
 - 14 Vendors
 - 81 Products in FY 2021-2022
- Group Licensing for electronic resources paid by institutions
 - Price negotiations, contracts, licensing
 - \$2.3 million for 2021-2022 funded by participating libraries
 - 39 Vendors
 - 156 Products
- Authentication Platform OpenAthens
 - Used by 38 state colleges and universities (2 universities use locally-hosted EZProxy)


